

### **Native STEAM Camp**

In July we took part in the Native STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Mathematics) Camp. Participants learned about the ecology of the plants and animals in Kumeyaay territory, traditional foods, geology and ocean life. They also learned many skills like how to make a willow bark skirt, halma or gourd rattle, and tule boats.
